Grants are awarded in varying amounts depending on the project. Recipients are required to write a follow-up report describing the project and detailing how the funds were spent.

### **OUR SCHOLARSHIPS**

The A.O.E. National Foundation awards scholarships on a yearly basis, with the number of scholarships awarded each year dependent upon donations received. In 2024, we awarded \$14,000 in scholarships to 15 recipients.

Standards for selection include promotion of engineering and technical science, character, conduct and integrity, academic achievement and scholastic aptitude, as well as community involvement and extracurricular activities. Applicants must be undergraduate student enrolled in or accepted for enrollment in a college or university accredited by ABET (Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology).

The final selection of scholarship recipients is made by an independent judging panel consisting of representatives from the field of education and/or engineering and science professions who have been selected by the Board of Directors.

The scholarships are tax-exempt, made payable directly to the school of the recipient, and can only be used for tuition, fees, books, course materials, course supplies, or other items directly connected to education. (Winners must sign a Scholarship Recipient Agreement which describe the guidelines the recipient must uphold).
